




NAOMI AND RUTH

Twelve 30-day months would bring the year's total to 360 days, but 4 season days brings the count to 364, sans a leap week. Leap weeks are explained in *The Hebrew Calendar* documentary. They occur every sixth even-numbered year, which keeps the feasts in their proper seasons.
